


Our Musicians

Wednesday, January 17 Unsung Heroes







The debut concert of our new recital series features music written for two marvelous, unsung heroes—the richly timbered voice of the viola and the scintillating sound of the mandolin.

The program features virtuoso violist/mandolinist Rafael Ramirez and Steinway Ambassador pianist Tina Giorgio performing music by Beethoven, Bach, Schubert, Bartok, and more.

Wednesday, February 7 Beethoven the Transcendent





Beethoven composed five cello sonatas over the course of his creative life, three of which are included in this program. Sonata opus 5 no. 2 is a youthful work. The opus 102 sonatas contain features typical of the master's late period, including unconventional form, deeply probing emotional expression and complex exploration of fugue, requiring transcendental technique and emotional maturity.
