George Maxman was born in Moscow, Russia. He attended the Moscow Conservatory, studying violin with David Oistrakh and composition with Dmitri Kabalevsky. He emigrated from the Soviet Union in 1980 and has built an international career, with teaching and performing in Australia (Sydney, Melbourne, and Perth symphonies), the United States (Houston, Boston symphonies), Canada (Symphony Nova Scotia), and China (Shanghai Conservatory Symphony Orchestra as conductor). He has taught violin in each of the countries, and his students have been top prize winners in numerous competitions. He and his wife reside in Bradenton, FL. He has composed numerous compositions, including an opera and two ballets.
