Soloist/Recitalist Biographies



Italian born harpist Giuseppina Ciarla is a classical musician and a groundbreaking crossover performer combining her artistry of harp and voice. Principal harpist with the Sarasota Opera since 2002, Giuseppina Ciarla has performed with world class conductors such as Lorin Maazel, Yannick Nézet-Séguin, Victor DeRenzi, and Daniel Oren, to name a few. She has recorded for Bongiovanni and Koch record labels. She is the harpist of the Chamber Orchestra of Sarasota.



Beginning his viola studies at an early age in Venezuela, violist and mandolin player Rafael Ramirez became involved in classical music with "el Movimiento Simon Bolivar" in 1992. His honors include 2nd place at the State Mandolin Festival, Capacho, Venezuela, a full scholarship with the Slava Bogu String Quartet, Bogotá, Colombia, and First Prize winner of the chamber music competition at Florida International University (2006 and 2007). He holds a Doctorate in Music Performance from the University of Miami and is principal viola of the Chamber Orchestra of Sarasota and Venice Symphony, and performs with the Miami Symphony, Lakeland Symphony, Palm Beach Pops, and many other Florida orchestras. Dr. Ramirez has created Music Educational Tools® didactic tools to aid string performers to acquire the necessary skills to develop technique.





Soloist/Recitalist Biographies

Pianist Tina Giorgio is a Steinway Company Ambassador. Giorgio began her studies with Madame Genia Robinor and is a graduate of the Manhattan Conservatory of Music. Giorgio has performed in Festivals in Germany, Austria, Switzerland, France, Iceland and Italy, and currently with the Bradshaw and Buono International Competition.

Violinist Cindi Qi received her Bachelor of Music from the Chicago College of Performing Arts at Roosevelt University where she played with the Civic Orchestra of Chicago, and received her MM from the Cincinnati Conservatory of Music. She is principal second violin of the Punta Gorda Symphony and associate concertmaster of the Chamber Orchestra of Sarasota. She also performs regularly with the Southwest Florida Orchestra and Villages Philharmonic. She has performed with the COS since 2018.

Violinist David Qi attended Central Conservatory in Beijing to study violin performance, and in 1988 he became a violinist for the China National Orchestra. He relocated to the United States in 1994, where he studied at the University of Miami. David has been a member of the COS since 2018, is member of Sarasota Orchestra, and assistant concertmaster of the Punta Gorda Symphony.

Cellist Scott Kluksdahl has performed for nearly four decades as chamber musician, recitalist and soloist in the United States, Europe, Israel, and Central and South America. Strings Magazine identified Scott Kluksdahl as "a simply superb cellist, playing with consummate technical ease, a beautiful sound, total conviction, authority and dedication to the music." He has made acclaimed recordings on Nimbus, Crystal, and Albany labels. Kluksdahl is Professor of Cello at the University of South Florida, and principal cello of the Chamber Orchestra.

Pianist Grigorios Zamparas has received critical acclaim for his versatile performing career as recitalist, orchestra soloist and chamber musician in Greece, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, former Yugoslavia, Austria, Russia, Brazil, South Korea and the US. Newport Daily News called him "...sensational..." He is a Professor of Music and the head of the piano program at The University of Tampa. He holds a DMA degree from the University of Miami and degrees from Indiana University (MM), University of Indianapolis (BM), and the Aristotle University of Thessalonica, Greece.

Praised by The New Yorker as an "exceptional young artist" and by the Sarasota Herald-Tribune as a "major talent," American **pianist Matthew Graybil** has performed as a recitalist, concerto soloist and chamber musician throughout the United States, Canada, Europe and Mexico. He has been a prize-winner in national and international competitions including the New York Piano Competition, the MTNA/Yamaha National Piano Competition, the Juilliard Gina Bachauer Competition, and the Nina Wideman International Piano Competition.

Violinist George Maxman was born in Moscow, Russia. He attended the Moscow Conservatory, studying violin with David Oistrakh and composition with Dmitri Kabalevsky. He emigrated from the Soviet Union in 1980 and has built an international career, with teaching and performing in Australia (Sydney, Melbourne, and Perth symphonies), the United States (Houston, Boston symphonies), Canada (Symphony Nova Scotia), and China (Shanghai Conservatory Symphony Orchestra as conductor). His students have been top prize winners in numerous competitions. He and his wife reside in Bradenton, Florida.






